Stormwater information, including tips on how to reduce stormwater pollution, a description of stormwater management, non point source pollution information and a list of runoff contaminants has been distributed District-wide. Agendas and minutes of District Board meetings are available on the District website. The Eco-Savers Club and Helping Teachers Program distribute literature and assist teachers with instruction on water quality and sustainability practices.

B. Briefly summarize the observations that indicated the overall effectiveness of this Measurable Goal.

Six distinct pieces of stormwater literature were posted on prominent bulletin boards in each school building. The amount of trash recycled has increased by approximately seventy five percent, while non-recyclable trash debris has decreased by about twenty five percent. The District as a whole educates its population, and implements when possible, "green technology" and sustainable initiatives.

The District continues its agreement with the Village to vacuum and monitor catch basins on District property. There is a contract in place with a hauling company for waste storage and recycling dumpsters. Surveying and mapping of catch basins and storm drain locations at each school including outfalls is available in AutoCad format.

B. Briefly summarize the observations that indicated the overall effectiveness of this Measurable Goal.

District vehicles continue to be fueled and maintained off-site; catch basins are cleaned and inspected twice yearly. Maintenance of catch basins is done on an as needed basis. A no-mow policy is in place to protect vegetative buffers. The carting contract provides for inspection and replacement every six months or on an as needed basis.
