Scarsdale Union Free School District Parents' Bill of Rights for Student Data Privacy and Security

The Scarsdale Union Free School District, in recognition of the risk of identity theft and unwarranted invasion of privacy, affirms its commitment to safeguarding student *Personally Identifiable Information (PII)* in *Educational Records* from unauthorized access or disclosure, in accordance with State and federal law. The Scarsdale Union Free School District establishes the following *Parents' Bill of Rights*:

- Student *PII* will be collected and disclosed only when necessary, in order to achieve educational purposes in accordance with State and federal law.
- Student *PII* cannot be sold or released for any marketing or commercial purposes by the District or any third-party contractor. The District and its employees will not sell student *PII* and will not release it for marketing or commercial purposes.
- Parents have the right to inspect and review the complete contents of their child's *Education Record*.
- State and federal laws, such as NYS Education Law §2-d and the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), protect the confidentiality of student *PII*. Safeguards associated with industry standards and best practices, including but not limited to, encryption, firewalls, and password protection, must be in place when data is stored or transferred.

- Parents have the right to report complaints about possible breaches and unauthorized disclosures of student data. Complaints should be directed in writing to the Superintendent of Schools at 2 Brewster Road, Scarsdale, NY 10583. Complaints can also be directed to the New York State Education Department online at https://www.nysed.gov/data-privacy-security/report-improper-disclosure, by mail to the Chief Privacy Officer, New York State Education Department, 89 Washington Avenue, Albany, NY 12234, or by email to privacy@nysed.gov, or by telephone at 518-474-0937.
- Parents have the right to be notified in accordance with applicable laws and regulations if a breach or unauthorized release of their child's *PII* occurs.
- Parents can expect that educational agency workers who handle PII will receive annual training on applicable federal and State laws, regulations, educational agency's policies and safeguards that support industry standards and best practices to protect *PII*.
- In the event that the District engages a third-party provider to deliver student educational services, the contractor or subcontractors will be obligated to adhere to State and federal laws to safeguard student *PII*.
