

# Smart Schools Bond Phase 2

Board Report, May 2022

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# Overview

- **Bond approved by New York State voters in 2014**
- **Allocates funds to both public and non-public schools to “finance improved educational technology and infrastructure to improve learning and opportunity for students throughout the State.”**
- **Other approved initiatives include “high-tech security” and pre-K programs. These items, along with any network-related requests, require additional documentation.**

# Overview

- **There is no deadline for submitting an application for funds.**
- **Program was designed to use funds over several years or phases.**
- ***There is no timeline for approving funding requests at the state level.*** Intent was for the Smart Schools Review Board to meet quarterly, but that has not happened.
