## SCARSDALE SCHOOLS BOND REFERENDUM

The Scarsdale Board of Education, after months of consultations with community stakeholders, is calling for a bond referendum on **Thursday**, **December 11**, 2014, in the amount of **\$18.12 million** for repairs, upgrades, and limited new construction in District buildings.

- The development of 21st century skills calls for reconfigured facilities that support collaborative, interdisciplinary learning.
- Annual budgets have been unable to keep up with repairs.
- The new borrowings will be tax-neutral, due to maturing debt in 2015.
- Issuing a bond now enables the District to take advantage of historically low interest rates.

## PROPOSED PROJECTS FOR SCARSDALE SCHOOLS



 New Middle School Orchestra Rehearsal Space, Music Classroom Renovations (\$2,097,000)

- Upgrades to District Technology Infrastructure (\$1,400,000)
- Roof Replacement at Quaker Ridge (\$908,000)
- At the High School:
  - A Learning Commons and Innovation Lab will provide space for eating and group study, alleviating overcrowding in the cafeteria and library. (\$5,091,000)
  - A Design Lab will be located in the abandoned auto shop. The Scarsdale Schools Education Foundation (SSEF) will cover most costs; bond funds will cover relocation of storage and offices. (\$677,000)
  - Auditorium repairs (drainage, seating, lighting) are proposed. (\$1,000,000)
  - The Fitness Center will move to a larger space below Gyms 3-4.
    This is not funded by the bond; it will be paid for by the SSEF and funds previously approved by voters. The Madoff family is donating the equipment in memory of their son, Tyler.
