Try-Outs

Try-outs will be held at Scarsdale High School on **Wednesday**, **February 24th**. Due to Covid-19 restrictions, the try-out schedule will be announced by the SHS Athletic Department. **Rowers are required to be able to swim**.

What to wear: Face mask, exercise clothing & sneakers. Nothing too loose as it will catch on the erg handle.

What to bring: Full water bottle and the attached completed Information Form. PCRA Coaches will collect this form at try-outs.

Notifications about team placement will be shared via email no later than Thursday, February 25th. When placement has been determined, we will register your student and you will receive a comprehensive email with additional information, including required forms (swim test, liability waiver, medical history), uniform order and gear order information. Please do not register your child yourself.

Fees / Items NOT covered by Scarsdale High School:

- A basic USRowing membership is required to participate, (about \$10)
- Uniforms, required for Race Team rowers (about \$85)
- PCRA's Parent Association provides meals and snacks at every regatta for rowers and their families (approximately \$125 / season). Due to Covid-19, this is subject to a regular regatta season.
- Parents are responsible for getting your rower to regattas, SHS does not provide a bus
- Parents are responsible for overnight regatta hotels, SHS does not provide hotels
- Post-season training and travel for athletes qualified for Youth Nationals (fee TBD)
- Spirit Gear store will be open the first week of practice (optional)
